**RLF COMPLETES CONVERSION PROJECT FOR  
LAKE HIGHLAND PREPARATORY SCHOOL**

Orlando, Fla. – RLF, Inc. – a Winter Park-based architecture, engineering and interior design firm – recently completed a revitalization project at Lake Highland Preparatory School’s Charles Clayton campus on Mills Avenue. RLF converted the former North Park Baptist Church into a middle school for Lake Highland Preparatory School.

RLF retained the church’s façade – which has been a community landmark since 1960 – while thoroughly updating and refurbishing the property. As part of the continuing Colonialtown revitalization, green space was added and streetscape improvements were made along Mills Avenue.

The school is designed to serve 400 students with 17 classrooms, four science rooms, two computer labs, a media center, a wood floor gymnasium and locker rooms, and an art room. The former Sanctuary now provides auditorium seating for approximately 750 people for lectures, music and drama productions, and student gatherings.

Creating a safe environment at the Charles Clayton campus drove design decisions such as locating administration offices at the main entrance. This location establishes a single point of entry for the gated campus allowing clear observation and control of all visitors on campus. In addition, there are separate drop-off and pick-up points for bus drivers and parents providing safe boarding and pick-up with improved traffic flow.
